Description

The Executive Master's in Public Health Emergency Management program is specifically designed to equip health professionals and students with the advanced knowledge and practical skills needed to lead during public health crises. From managing emergencies to strengthening health systems and promoting community resilience, this program prepares you to take on leadership roles in complex crisis scenarios.

Key Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the program, participants will be able to:

- Lead health services and teams during emergencies with confidence and expertise.
- Implement evidence-based strategies in managing public health crises.
- Conduct public health research, contributing to policy development.

This program provides a comprehensive education in public health emergency management, combining theory, practice, and research.

Program Structure

The program is divided into **three subprograms**, each designed to build on essential skills for managing public health emergencies. Participants will complete the coursework over **nine months**, followed by a 3-month supervised thesis project.

Subprogram 1:

Basics of Public Health Emergency Management

Duration: 3 Months (First Quarter)

Public Health Risk Management

Duration: 3 Months (Second Quarter)

- Module 1: Public Health Tools and Techniques in Challenging Conditions
- Module 2: Public Health Risk Management
- Module 3: Risk Communication
- Module 4: Public Health Management of Mass Gatherings
- Module 5: Community-Based Risk Management
- Module 6: Biostatistics

Subprogram 3:

Managing Primary Healthcare Services in Emergencies

Duration: 3 Months (Third Quarter)

Modules:

- Module 1: Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases in Emergencies
- Module 2: Women and Child Health in Humanitarian Settings
- Module 3: Nutrition in Emergencies
- Module 4: Environmental Health in Emergencies
- Module 5: Scientific Writing
- Module 6: Proposal Submission

Thesis Project

Duration: 3 Months (Fourth Quarter)

Participants will complete a **3-month** supervised research project on a real-world public health emergency, supervised by recognized advisors. They will apply their skills to develop solutions for complex public health challenges.

Certification

Graduates will receive a Professional Certificate equivalent to a master's degree, recognized globally for its academic and professional value.

Training Hours

The program comprises 860 contact hours (37 credit hours), ensuring a deep and comprehensive education in public health emergency management.

Admission Requirements

- **Bachelor's degree** in health sciences or any related field from a recognized educational institution; or a certificate of prior learning recognition at the same level.
- **Letter of interest** detailing interest in the program and how the master's degree will support personal and professional growth.
- **Proficiency** in English is required.
- **Preferred:** At least one year of experience in public health.
